Nadine Hill, from Portsmouth, lived on £80 a week, when she appeared on the Channel 5 docuseries Rich House, Poor House in 2019 and had more than £20,000 in debt, but she's now paid off what she owed and has her own successful business



So much was Nadine's success, that after the initial show aired, Channel 5 commissioned Emporium Productions to film a 1 hour special follow up show.

The show titled, 'Rich House, Poor House Changed My Life' showed Nadine's Journey from struggling single mum on benefits with huge debts, to not only clearing all her debts, but becoming a successful permanent makeup artist with her own clinic, within just 12 months!

All whilst a global pandemic was causing chaos throughout the world!



Commenting on how the Channel 5 show has transformed her - both personally and professionally - Nadine said: "I felt trapped before when I didn't have much money.

"Rich House, Poor House changed my life massively because I'm out of debt now, I've got a new career and I'm so grateful and I'm so excited for the future," the mum-of-one added.

Following on from her appearance on the inspirational life swap documentary, *Rich House, Poor House,* award-winning permanent make-up trainer Katy Jobbins has now featured in a specially commissioned follow-up programme.

Katy, who is the founder and head trainer of the Permanent Makeup Training Academy, swapped lives with single mum, Nadine, a part-time hairdresser from Portsmouth. At the end of the original episode, Katy offered to train Nadine in permanent make-up for free and provide business mentoring to kick-start her new career.

Although the pandemic somewhat halted Nadine's plans, the new Channel 5 show – Rich House, Poor House Chanaed Mv Life

– saw her catch up with Katy at her newly opened make-up clinic and share stories of how the swap their lives over the last 12 months.





Here are a selection of some of our favourites...





Student "Spot Light" Case Study

Meet Kaley, who started her permanent makeup career, training 1 to 1 with Katy in 2017. At the time of her training she was a front line social worker with absolutely zero beauty experience, supporting some amazing families, but after having her first child she was ready for a change and new challenge.

Since then, she has now created her dream job, in her gorgeous garden studio, working on her own incredible clients. In 2020, she also won not just 1, but 2 major awards at the National British Hair & Beauty Awards, including the winner of 'Best Semi-Permanent Make-up Artist.

Returning for her own treatments 2 years after her initial training course, here is what she had to say.

'I had 2 small children so I was really glad I did my career in social work. I did it for 7 years, but it was quite stressful at times and there were some late finishes & you couldn't really choose your hours. The children had to go to nursery for long hours. So I wanted a change really.

I trained with Katy, which was amazing and then went on to build it up slowly so at first I was doing social work alongside the permanent makeup for about a year. Then when I had my son, I finished social work completely & was able to carry on through my maternity leave doing permanent makeup & built it up from there really.

Before I was renting rooms in salons which was great but obviously now I'm fortunate enough to have the studio so it's brilliant. I can do whatever time I want. Sometimes I might see a client at 9pm at night and that's ok and sometimes first thing in the morning, I was in at 7am the other day.


You can choose your hours completely & obviously not having the out going or rent it's working really well for me.

The supports been amazing. I think that's been probably the best. I mean obviously the course was fantastic, but the support from Katy in the early days if I ever had an issue come up or needed to ask a question or anything, Katy would respond straight away. There was never a time where she wasn't available & it was really, really helpful just to know that I have got

her there should I need it. Also the fact that you guys are supporting me even now with plans looking forward is brilliant as well.'
